Check In	Works check-in desk until check-in ends (7:30). Accurately record guests coming into shelter. After line slows assigns dinner tickets to each guest and store all medications and contraband accurately. Assists with tote movement and cleans check in area	none	limited to moderate	5:30-8:30
Volunteer Assistant	Helps at check in for the busy first rush. Assigns dinner tickets to each guest and store all medications and contraband accurately. Moves to pulling totes for returning guests after line gets slow. Helps with tote movement after check in. Helps with cleaning after check in	none	limited to moderate	5:30-8:30
FM Assistant	Provides self service medication administration, monitors cameras and assists the Facility Manager	none	limited to high (volunteer choice)	5:30-8:30
Guest Services	Ensures all new guest receive and understand welcome packet - assisting in filling out paperwork, basic needs and building orientation. Monitors guests throughout the building and yurt by doing regular rounds and reporting to staff any issues. Assists in welcoming and training all new volunteers. Assists staff as needed. Cover volunteer roles when breaks are needed	Experience necessary	high	5:30-9:00
Weekend Volunteer - (some churches may not choose to offer these slots. Delete as necessary)	Assist guests with laundry, showers and coffee. Perform rounds and help staff with other activities as directed.	none	high	Three shifts (between 8-5)
